

## HUMPHREYS COUNTY MUSEUM AND CIVIL WAR FORT

A STATE OF THE STA

In the last half of the Civil War, Johnsonville was a critical supply depot for Union forces occupying Nashville and much of the mid-south. Union forces built a fort overlooking the town and the area. The fort is in the backyard of a 1922 Mansion which now serves as a museum and treasure trove of historical information. The Museum includes a Civil War Room, World War I Room, World War II Building, Jesse James Exhibit, Captain Anderson Exhibit and other interesting collections donated by Humphreys County residents.
