HUMPHREYS COUNTY MUSEUM AND CIVIL WAR FORT

In the last half of the Civil War, Johnsonville was a critical supply depot for Union forces occupying Nashville and much of the mid-south. Union forces built a fort overlooking the town and the area. The fort is in the backyard of a 1922 Mansion which now serves as a museum and treasure trove of historical information. The Museum includes a Civil War Room, World War I Room, World War II Building, Jesse James Exhibit, Captain Anderson Exhibit and other interesting collections donated by Humphreys County residents. It is also an event venue for rent for weddings, showers, teas and other special events.
