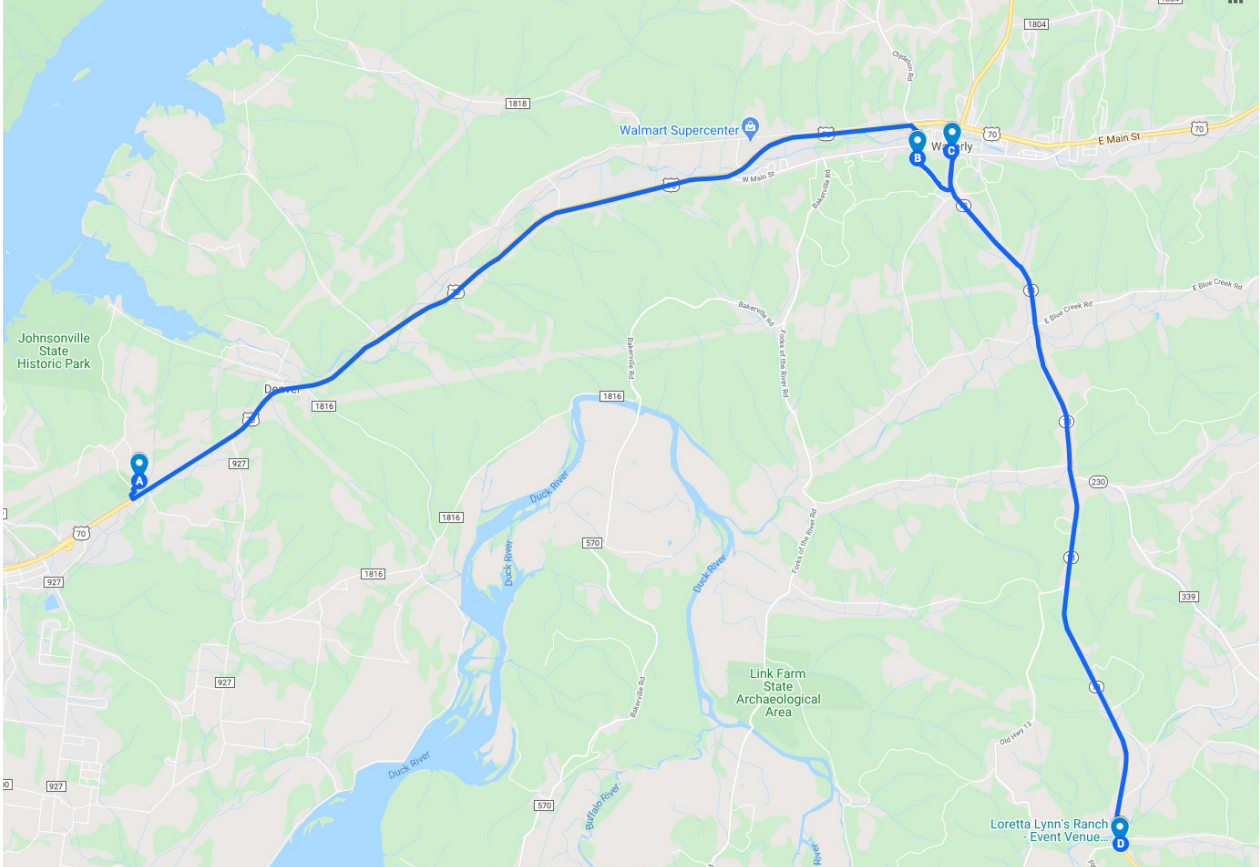
5. LORETTA LYNN'S RANCH
