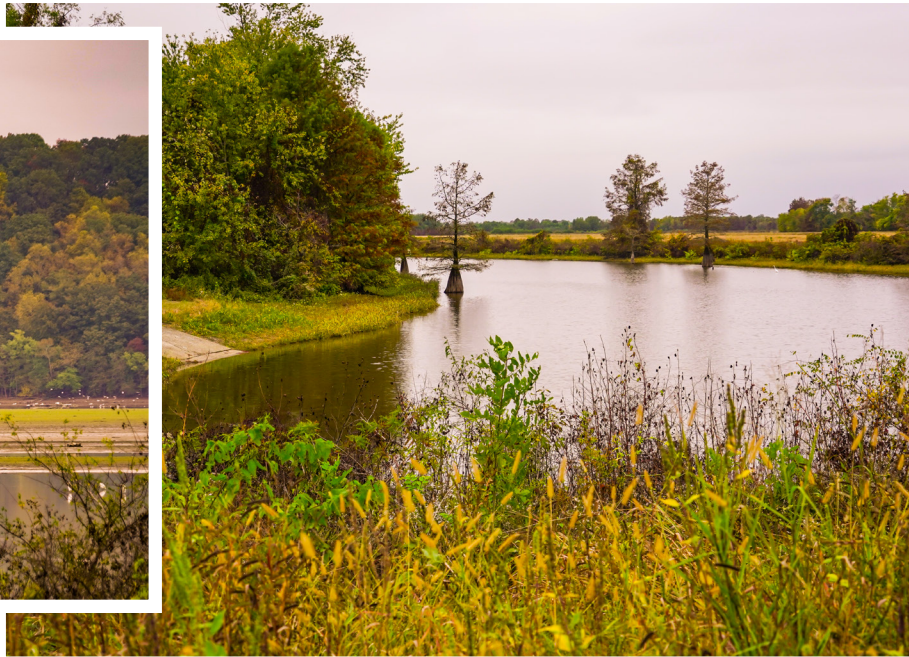

1. BONE'S CANOE & CAMPGROUND
